- I planned with the other team leaders the stack to work on the different projects, making proposals about frameworks, pattern designs and cloud solutions that increase the efficiency of the development team at the moment of writing code and developing features, improving productivity and delivering deadlines.
- I optimize cloud architectures and projects availability by designing scalable architectures in AWS taking care about security and availability.
- I did an optimization of one of our architectures reducing costs by 50% by reducing traffic through the Nat Gateways and implementing VPC Endpoints to manage internal traffic between AWS Services.

- As a member of the team I increased the performance of the procedure to manage user sessions by proposing a queuing process using SNS, SQS and a microservice in charge of processing them, which managed to reduce the load on the redis database by about 80%, which represented an improvement in the user experience.
- I was assigned as the leader of the team I was working on, as a leader I was able to successfully manage a team of 4 developers and increased the successful completion of deadlines by 25% by performing a good distribution of tasks depending on the capabilities of the team members, modularization of the same and accurate estimates, improving deadlines delivering and team productivity.
- I worked with the AWS Architect of my team in order to optimize the CI/CD procedures and reduce bitbucket pipeline time execution using shared dependencies between pipeline steps and running steps in parallel. These changes represented an improvement in the deployment time of the different development environments.
